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The Meeting commenced with a Welcome address by the member Director IQAC. He welcomed all the Coordinators of the IQAC to the meeting.

The following agendas were placed for Discussion.

Agenda - 01: Previous Task Review

Several departments have yet to submit complete academic and event data. This has resulted in inconsistent reporting across the institutions, leading to gaps in assessment and documentation. Incomplete entries hinder university-wide tracking and dilute IQAC visibility.

Agenda - 02: Academic Calendar Submission

It was emphasized that all coordinators must submit their final academic calendars, which focus on non-routine activities such as FDPs, MDPs, workshops, and conferences, by Tuesday. This is crucial for aligning and consolidating efforts across departments to ensure synchronization at the university level.

Agenda - 03: Benchmarking and NIRF Preparation

All institutions are to benchmark with 10–12 comparable universities using the GSIR and NIRF parameters. Coordinators were guided to analyze institutional performance against these metrics and identify specific areas for improvement. Emphasis was placed on using benchmarking for strategic development planning.

Agenda - 04: Alumni Association Strengthening

Only four institutions have a registered alumni association. Other coordinators were instructed to explore the technical and legal feasibility of establishing formal alumni associations. A policy on the utilization of the alumni fund for scholarships, research, or development is being designed.

Agenda - 05: IDP Registration

The deadline for the final submission of Institutional Development Plans (IDP) was set for 24th July 2025. Coordinators must ensure timely online registration and submission, including strategic priorities for the next three years.

Agenda - 06: Centre of Excellence

Coordinators were encouraged to develop proposals for Centers of Excellence in collaboration with industry leaders, including L&T, Cisco, Google Cloud, and Microsoft. These centers focus on innovation, skilling, and job readiness in domain-specific areas.

Agenda - 07: FDP & Training Plans

A specialized Faculty Development Programme (FDP) for Health Science is under consideration. Plans



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to initiate digital competency and leadership training for department heads and deans were discussed. Institutions are to provide preferred dates and themes.

Agenda - 08: Website & Documentation Gaps

It was noted that institutional websites are missing essential information. Coordinators were asked to audit their department's web pages and ensure updates to profiles, achievements, programs, and compliance documents.

Agenda - 09: Faculty Performance Mapping

A structured review system categorizing faculty as Green (high-performing), Yellow (average), and Red (in need of support) was introduced. This classification will guide mentoring efforts, FDP participation, and strategic academic interventions.

Agenda - 10: Proposal Submission & Recognition

Proposals for research projects, awards, and institutional grants are often delayed or not submitted. Coordinators were asked to actively track upcoming deadlines and motivate faculty to submit well-prepared applications. A centralized proposal tracking system may be initiated.
