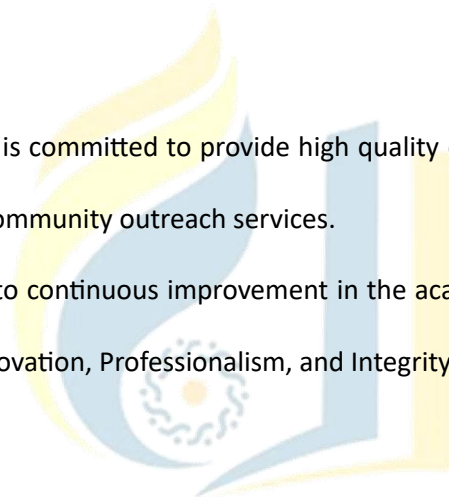

Sankalchand Patel University (SPU) is a higher education institution based in North Gujarat and offers a wide range of academic programs in various fields of study. Students pursue undergraduate and postgraduate education, conduct in-depth research, and engage in intellectual exploration. Established on 9th May 2016 by the Gujarat Private Universities (Amendment) Act, 2016. The SPU has **10,000+ students, 650+ teaching staff, and 700+ non-teaching staff**. SPU is recognised for its quality education and contributions to made in higher education and economic development.

Nootan Sarva Vidyalaya Kelavani Mandal (NSVKM), established in 1952 by Shri. Sankalchand Patel, a freedom fighter and social entrepreneur promotes Sankalchand Patel University, and supporting for educational and sociocultural needs of the people in North Gujarat. Shri. Sankalchand Patel dedicated himself to the freedom movement at a young age, with a strong desire to serve the people of North Gujarat. 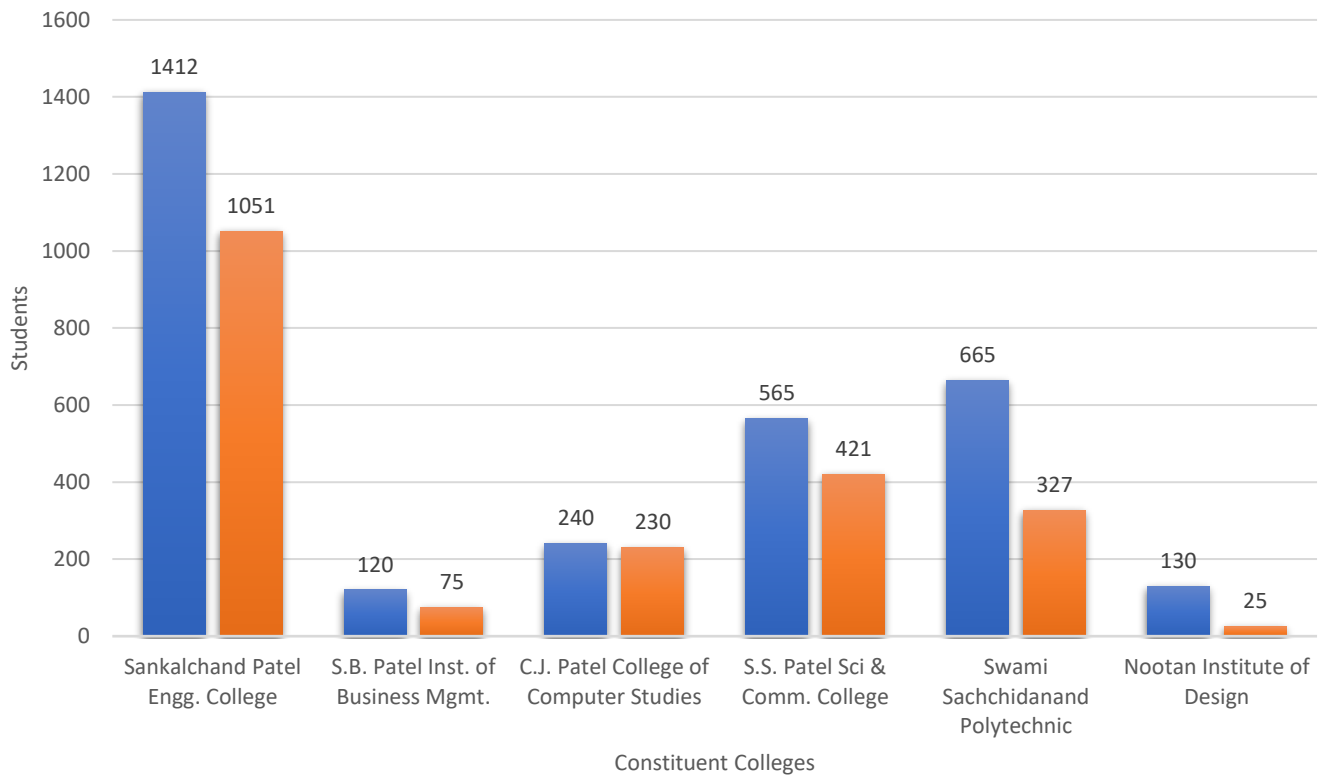

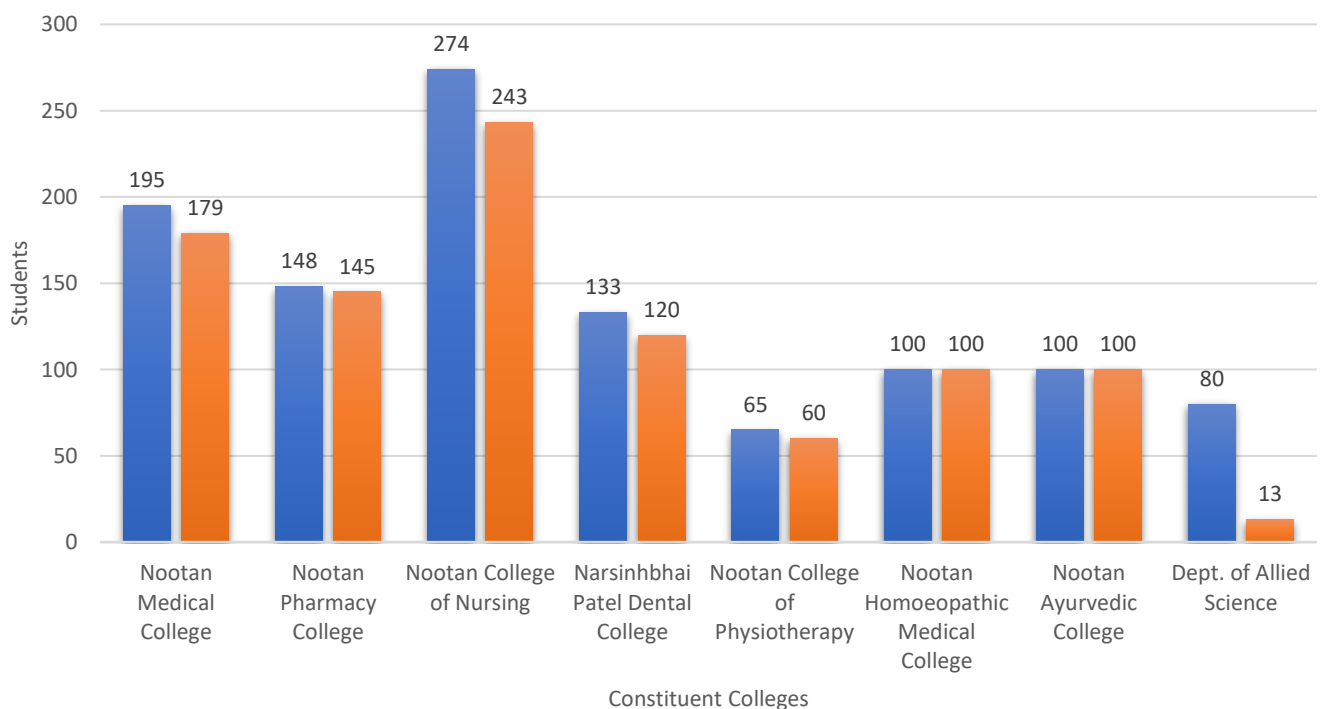


Sanctioned Intake and Admissions 2024-25

Health Science Institutes Intake vs Admissions



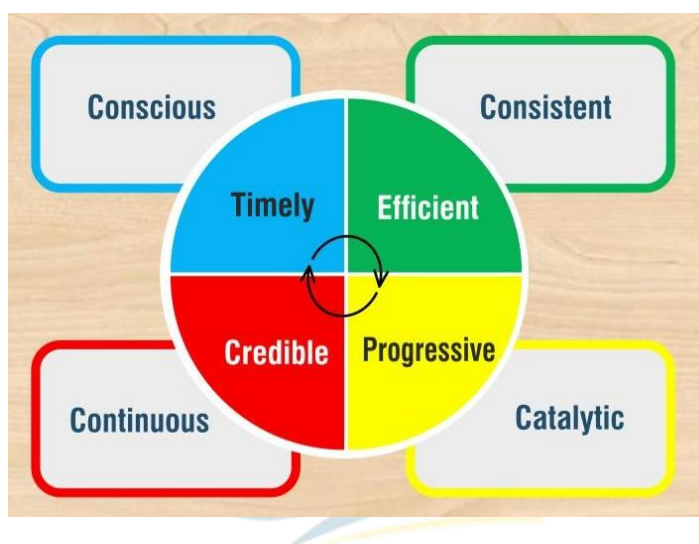

Best Practices

Tobacco Cessation Centre

In Gujarat, the Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS) shows a slight increase in the average age of initiation among adults—from 18.3 years in 2009–10 to 18.6 years in 2016–17. However, early uptake remains a concern. A 2019 study in Gujarat found that 5.4% of schoolchildren aged 13 to 15 were already using tobacco, with the median age of first use as low as 10.8 years. The Tobacco Cessation Centre, run by the Department of Public Health Dentistry, plays a vital role in helping individuals quit tobacco through structured support that combines clinical and behavioural approaches. A key strength of the centre is the presence of a clinical psychologist who provides focused behavioural counselling, addressing the psychological and emotional aspects of addiction. This is complemented by the use of a Smoke analyser, a specialized device that measures carbon monoxide levels in exhaled breath giving patients real-time feedback on the harmful effects of tobacco use. Each year, the centre benefits nearly 3,000 individuals, making it a critical community resource for reducing tobacco-related harm and promoting long-term health.

ISR and Community Outreach Programs

Gujarat continues to face a major challenge when it comes to oral health. Common problems like tooth decay, gum disease, and oral cancers—especially those linked to tobacco use—are widespread across both urban and rural populations. Unfortunately, many people are unaware of the importance of oral hygiene or are unable to access dental care, leading to delayed treatment and worsening of preventable conditions. Recognizing this gap, the Department of Public Health Dentistry at Narsinhbhai Patel Dental College and Hospital has taken several steps to improve oral health in the community.

Regular dental camps are organized in nearby areas to offer free check-ups, treatment, and referrals when needed. To ensure people in remote villages are not left behind, a **Mobile Dental Van** visits these locations with a team of professionals who offer on-the-spot care and guidance. Beyond treatment, the department is committed to long-term impact through health education. Door-to-door campaigns are conducted frequently, where trained staff educate families about daily oral hygiene practices, the harms of tobacco, and how to recognize early signs of oral disease.

Mentorship Program

The mission of the Mentor-Mentee Committee is to foster meaningful and sustained professional relationships driven by the needs of the program participants and built on a foundation of reciprocity. To that end, the committee:

- Identify/ Nominate members annually to volunteer their time as mentors in the program.
- Develops and implements mechanisms to match participants with the most appropriate mentors/mentees.
- Collects resources for Best Practices in successful mentoring relationships
- Offers guidance and support in creating and sustaining the mentoring relationship.
- Solicits and acts upon feedback from program participants about the effectiveness of the program.
- Organizes program events for mentors and mentees with parents.
- The Mentoring Committee meets monthly to determine the steps necessary to accomplish the objectives.
- Each class is equally distributed among 10 (approximate) mentors.

- Each mentor is assigned 8-10 student mentees.
- Each class has a coordinator who will interact with individual mentors and report to the committee.
- Provision in the timetable for mentorship meetings. Bimonthly recommended meetings with mentees, once a month with coordinators, and once a month all coordinators would meet with the committee.
- Action Taken Report (ATR) has been added to the register.

Guidelines for the Mentors/Coordinators

- Ensure at least 2 meetings with students per month. The meetings should take place during the 2nd and 4th weeks of each month. If any student is absent, permission or provision to meet on other slots can be given.
- The first week of the month, all mentors will meet their respective coordinators. [year wise]
- The 2nd Monday of every month, the coordinators will meet the mentoring committee.
- Registers will be continued, and mentors will be reassigned every new academic year.
- All committee members are encouraged to contribute materials to the development of mentoring.


